

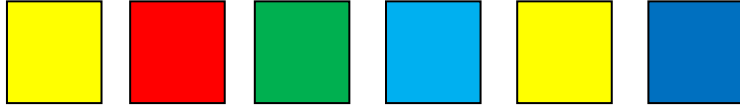
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Interpretation of Fractions - Step-by-Step Lesson

Lesson 1 Fractions Problem:

What fraction of the squares are yellow?



Explanation:

Step 1) First we need to know what is asked in question:

“What fraction of the squares are yellow?”

Step 2) Then, count the total number of squares. So we find that there are 6 squares. That will be the denominator of fraction.

Now count yellow squares.

2 squares are yellow color. That will be the numerator of fraction.

So the answer will be $\frac{2}{6}$
